This is a great time to take cuttings and divide perennials, but do it as soon as possible. Days are getting shorter and less sunlight signals the plants to slow down their growth.

Check the trees and shrubs in your yard one final time. Cut away dead wood and remove crossing limbs and branches that overhang the house. This will help with damages to your home.

Consider starting vegetables from seed. Try lettuce, lima beans, tomatoes, cabbage and broccoli. Seeds for annuals are salvia, verbena, ageratum, celosia, nasturtium. These are all good nectar for our butterflies and bees.

Continue to plant fruit trees and all shrubs. Also continue to mulch.
