Welcome back everyone to another wonderful year of gardening and sharing our ideas and plants with each other.

Now is the time to clean up our yards and decide if we want to grow a vegetable garden. If so, we have from September to November to plant seeds, or when small plants are available, start at the end of September to plant them, such as collards, peppers, tomatoes and broccoli.

Sometimes it's still very hot in September, so wait until October. This is a good time to take cuttings and dividing perennials. Continue to plant all trees and shrubs, but be sure to water them well. I'd like to recommend a plant of the month.

*Jatropha Integerrima* "Compacta". This tree or bush is one of the best source of nectar for butterflies and is always full of red flowers. As a good heat tolerant ground cover, try Variegated Baby Sun Rose.
